REQUIREMENTS

Cattle arriving Friday must be unloaded by 12pm, the cattle ramp will be unavailable after this time until Saturday morning. No late entries, an entry and indemnity form must be completed for each breed and entry fees paid in full prior to the commencement of judging. Age of the cattle as of the 1st May 2024. All led bulls 12 months or older must have nose rings, females, bulls under 12 months and steers must have nose dogs. Calves on cows may not be older than 9 months as of the 1st May 2025.

Cattle must not be exhibited unless tested for Pestivirus and certified as non Persistently Infected (PI) cattle. Certification of testing and proof of non PI status will be required at the time of entry in the form of a signed Veterinary Certificate or Laboratory Report, listing animals and their identification. Testing results will be verified by the Cattle Steward. A National Cattle Health Declaration must be completed for all cattle. All cattle must carry an NLIS device and owners are responsible for transferring and recording of the animals. Cattle must have an NVD Certificate and a copy to be supplied to the Steward, Showground PIC NG452050. The use of straw is prohibited.

Trophy presentation after judging, no trophies will be posted, perpetual trophies to be retained by the Narrabri Show Society. Angus and Red Angus will be judged together, Herefords and Poll Herefords will be judged together. All care will be taken with the handling of cattle on the grounds, but no risk to the Narrabri Show Society will be incurred.
