REQUIREMENTS

Display must be 1.2 x 1.2 m (primary/ high school) or 1m x 1m (preschool) in size and mounted on a board. 2. Must not contain plastic. 3. Mandatory 90% fresh produce grown by the school or donated to the school. 4. School emblem to be A3 size and waterproof, given to steward the day of display installation. 5. Dry and fresh herbs may be used, leafy greens and herbs to be displayed in water vessels or pots. 6. Trophy will be awarded to the highest point score. 7. Trophy winner will pick the theme for the following year. 8. Your chosen theme is to be in a sealed envelope, handed to steward. 9. The communication of theme is not to have identification of school.
