REQUIREMENTS

A completed entry form must be submitted for each exhibit/exhibitor at the time of delivery. Entries are to be submitted in a large envelope or snap-lock plastic bag with the exhibitor's name and phone number. All entries must be photographed by the exhibitor, developing and enlarging may be commercially done. No framed prints or postal entries.

The maximum number of entries is two (2) per person, per class. Entry sizes min 150mm x 100mm (6" x 4"), max 220mm x 155mm (8" x 6"). Panoramic, height unrestricted x length a min of 300mm to a max of 600mm (discuss height with your printer for recommendations). All prints must be mounted on thin flat cardboard (not paper) with a 30mm (3cm) border on all sides to allow for pinning. It is essential that the print is securely fastened to the cardboard with double-sided tape, so they do not fall off while being displayed.

Each entry must have exhibitor's name, phone number and class clearly marked on the back. Entries incorrectly classed will be reallocated to the correct class at the steward's discretion. Previous entries that have received a placing at the Narrabri Show are ineligible for resubmission.

All due care will be taken in handling and presentation of the exhibitor's work. However, no responsibility will be accepted for accidental damage/loss caused in transit or by misadventure during the display.

Tell a Story - all three (3) photos to be mounted on one (1) piece of cardboard and adhering to the size restrictions as the panoramic entries. Can be horizontal or vertically mounted with 30mm (3cm) between photos.

Creative entries - are by definition, photos that are intentionally altered so that they do not appear in their usual context, this includes filters. General Sections are not open to professional photographers, but you may enter the Special Class Prints (No.1 - No.5).

Am I considered a Professional? If you make an occasional income from selling your photos, then yes.

Overall size of mount no bigger than 600mm (see conditions for sizing limits).

2. I Love My Pet - Show us your love for your pet.
3. Show Theme '150 Years'.

Capture the essence of growing together in any setting.

4. Creative Imagery - Image altered by digital means i.e., photoshop.

Must show original and finished image and adhere to size limits listed in conditions.

5. Tell a Story - Using a series of three (3) photos that, when assembled in a particular order, tell a story. i.e., planting a seed, seedling growing, flower blooming.
