Open to young people aged 20 to 29, the Rural Achiever Program provides a platform for participants to share their vision for rural Australia, demonstrate leadership, and connect with like-minded individuals passionate about agriculture and community advancement.

The winner of the Narrabri Show Rural Achiever Program will receive ongoing mentorship and development opportunities through the Narrabri Show Society Youth Group, and will receive a letter of recommendation from the Narrabri Show Society if they choose to nominate for the RAS Rural Achiever Award at the Sydney Royal Easter Show.

This nomination offers the chance to join a network of high-achieving rural youth across New South Wales and take part in a week of leadership activities, ambassadorial responsibilities, and industry engagement at the state's most iconic agricultural event.

- **Open to males and females**
- **Entrants: Aged 20 to 29 years as of May 1st, 2026.**
- Entrants must reside, be educated, or work within Narrabri NSW for three months prior to the competition.
- Participation in the Narrabri Rural Achiever Program also includes:
 - Involvement in a shadow committee at the Narrabri Show
 - Opportunities to steward and support a variety of show sections
